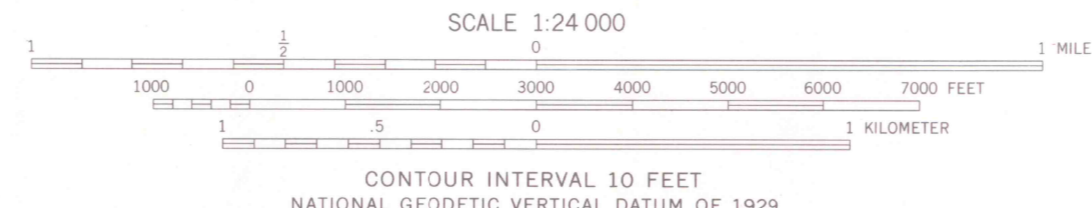

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines.
Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1978 and other source data. This information not field checked. Map edited 1979.
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas.
