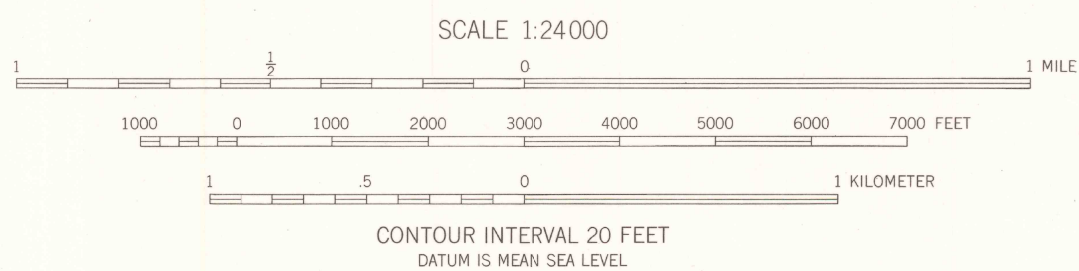
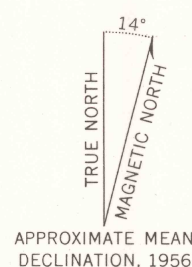
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Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods. Aerial photographs taken 1952 and 1953. Field check 1956.
