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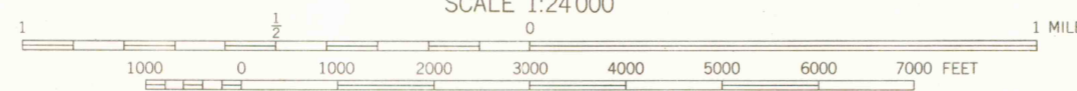
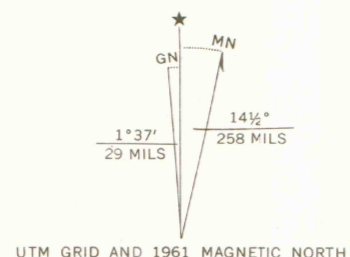

Where omitted, land lines have not been established or are not shown because of insufficient data

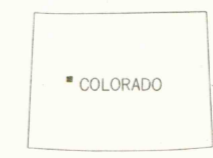
