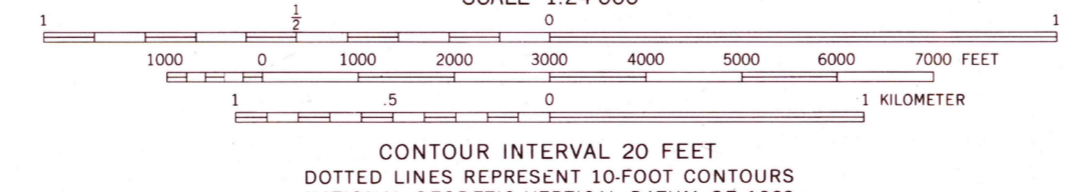
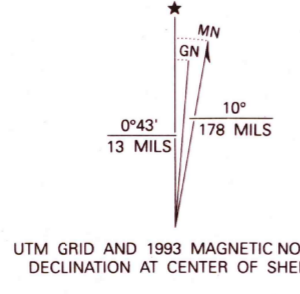


FORT CARSON MILITARY RESERVATION

The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83 for 7.5-minute intersections are given in USGS Bulletin 1875. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data.
