zone 13, shown in black

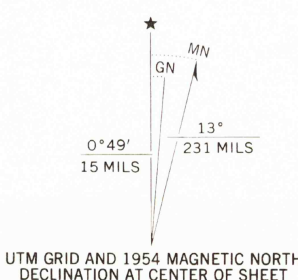
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983

No major culture or drainage changes observed

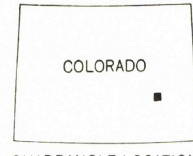
