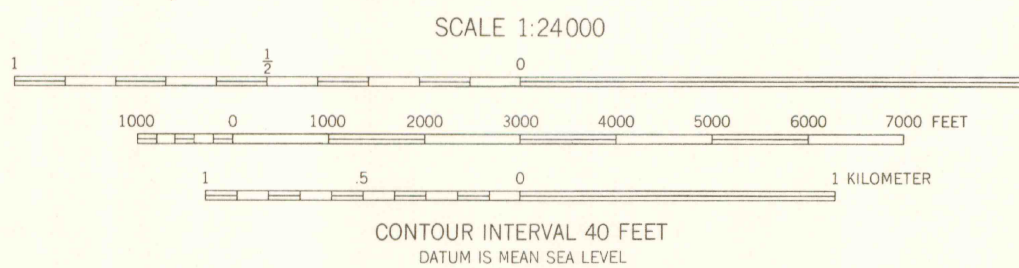

QUADRANGLE LOCATION

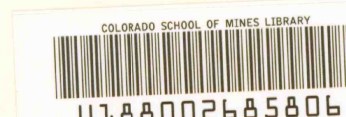
