

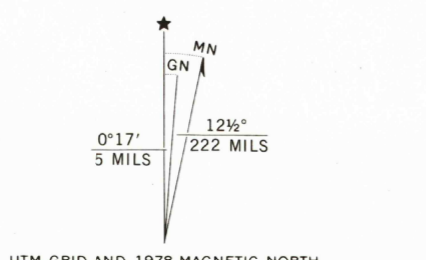

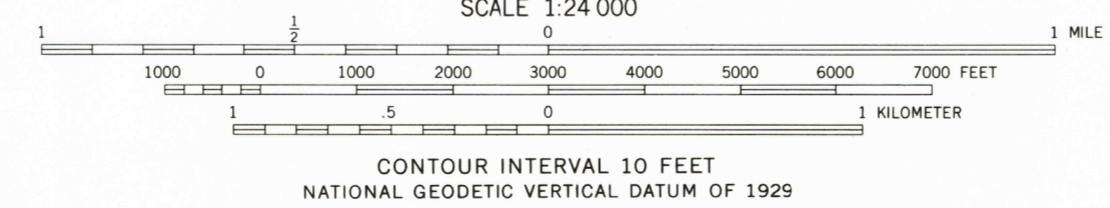

zone 13, shown in blue

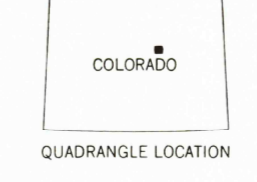


UTM GRID AND 1978 MAGNETIC NORTH
DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET

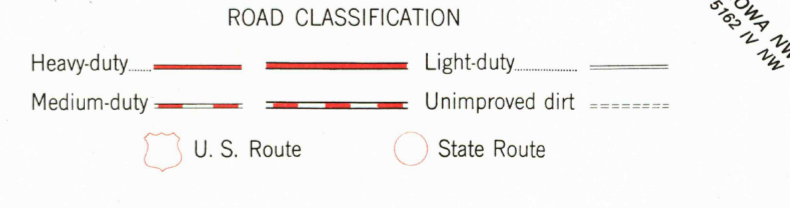

QUADRANGLE LOCATION

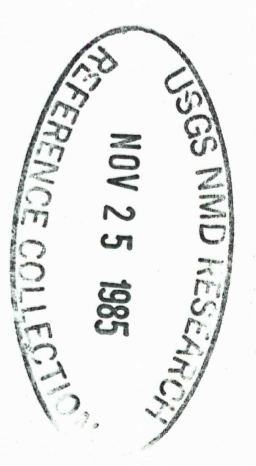
