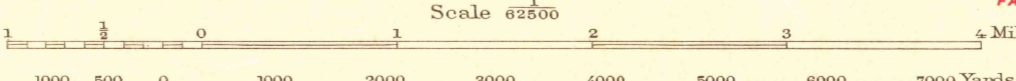


LEADVILLE 6 MI.
