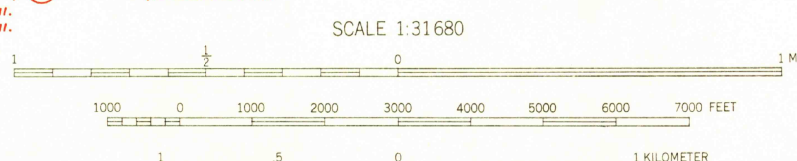
SW/4 GILEAD 15' QUADRANGLE

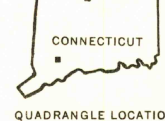
