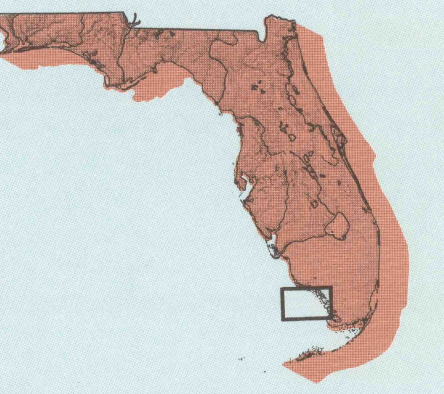
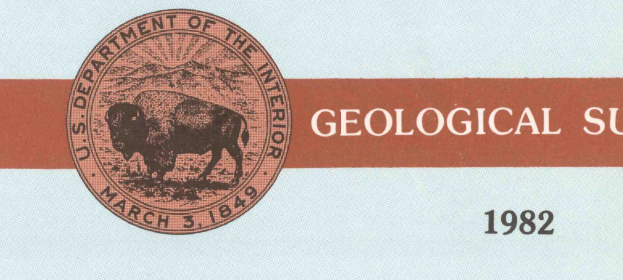


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of Everglades City FLORIDA

Projection and 10 000-meter grid, zone 17; Universal Transverse Mercator; 25 000-foot grid ticks based on Florida coordinate system, east zone, 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 39 meters south and 18 meters west. Oblique projection curves shown in red, compiled by the Bureau of Land Management. Heavy lines indicate limits of BLM Outer Continental Shelf Official Protection Diagrams dated December 2, 1976 and October 24, 1978. The projections on this map are not for Federal landing purposes; for such purposes, refer to the 1:250 000-scale OCS Official Protection Diagrams available from the Bureau of Land Management. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.

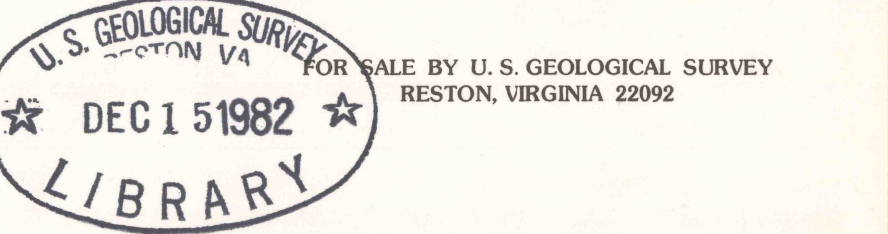
