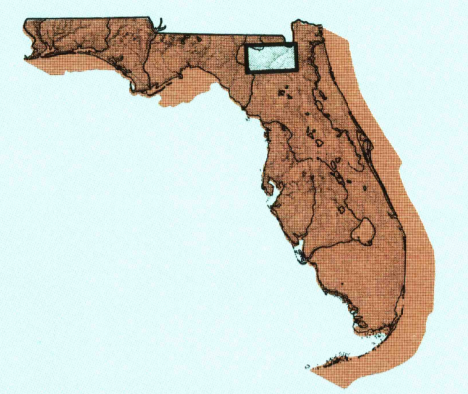
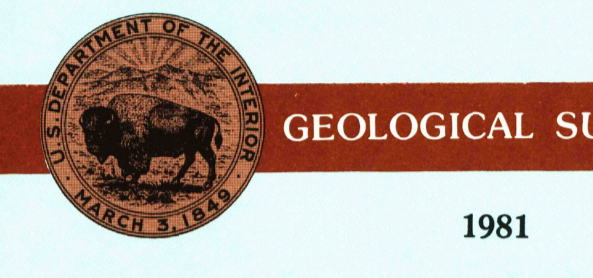


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of Lake City FLORIDA-GEORGIA
