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
Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1949 and 1951. Topography by planimetric surveys 1951. Field checked 1952.

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Florida coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue 1927 North American Datum (NAD 27).

North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks. The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83 for 7.5-minute intersections are given in USGS Bulletin 1875.

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations.
