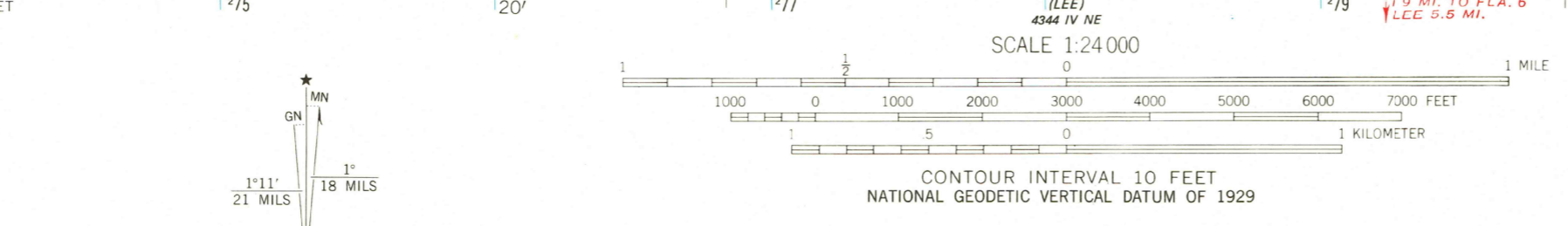

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 19 meters south and  
12 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
