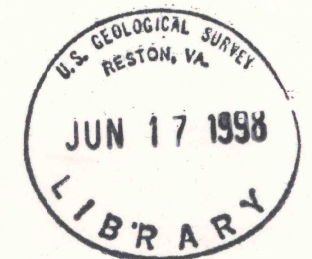
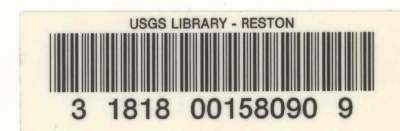
Polyconic projection
