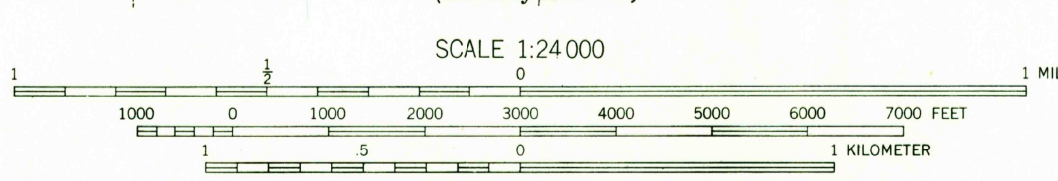


PANAMA CITY (JUNC. U. S. NO. 98) 13.7 MI.
