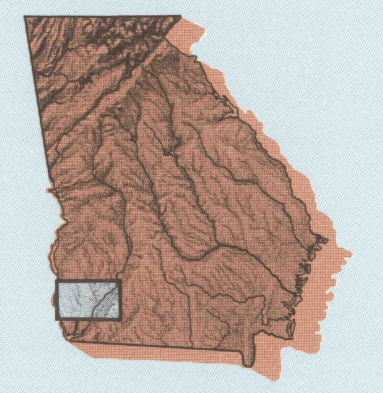
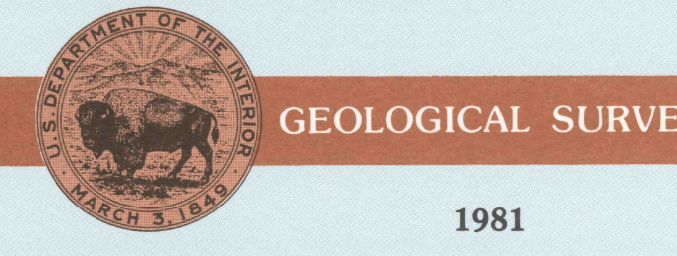


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of **Camilla** GEORGIA-ALABAMA

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
