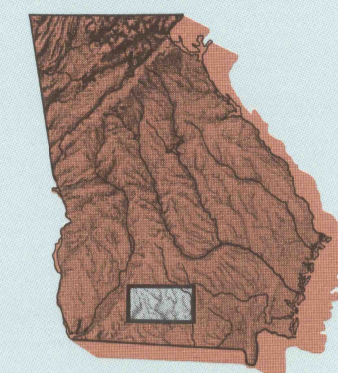
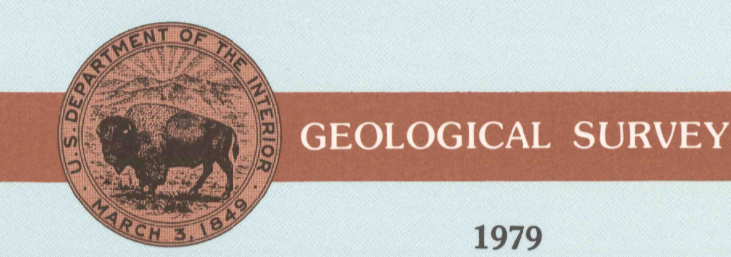


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of Moultrie GEORGIA

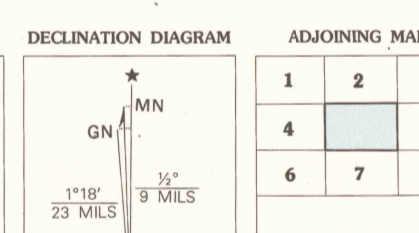

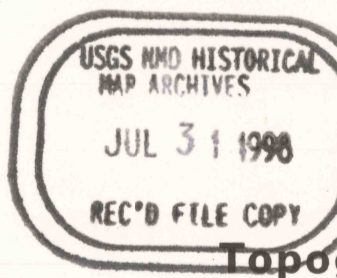
