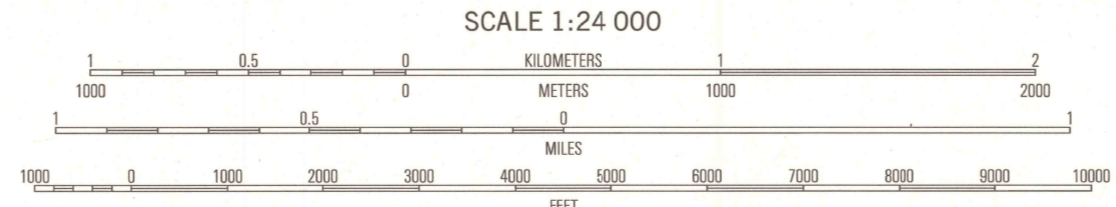
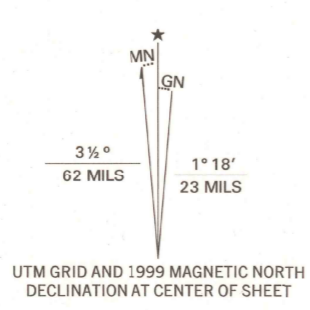


PINE LOG MOUNTAIN STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA
