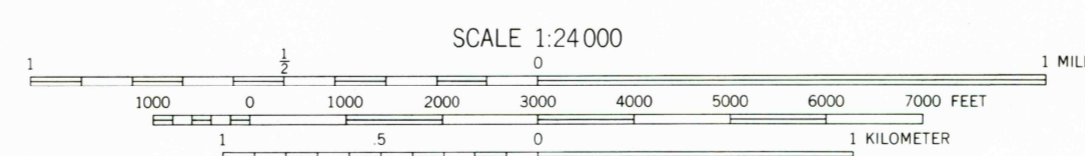
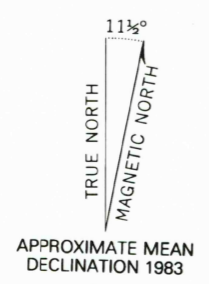

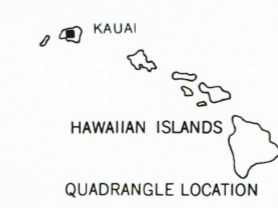

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 352 meters north and 288 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
