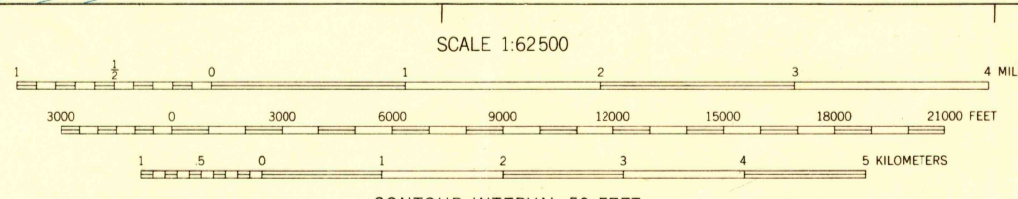




Map scale and coordinate markings on the left edge.
