

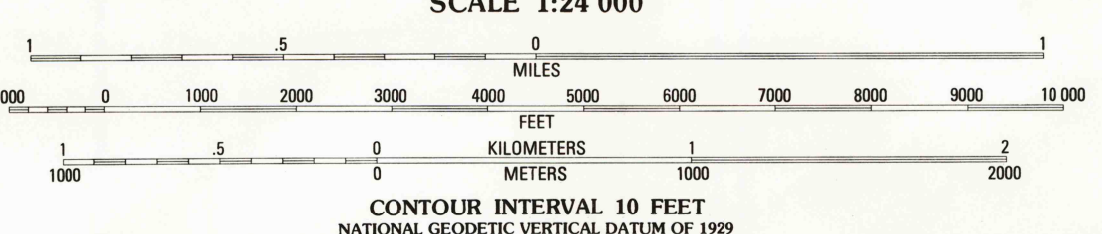
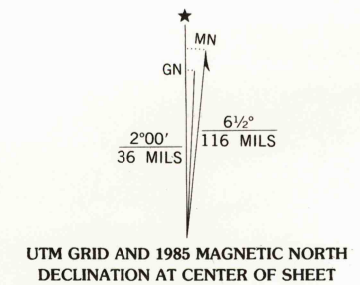

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 6 meters north and 25 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

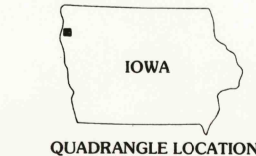
