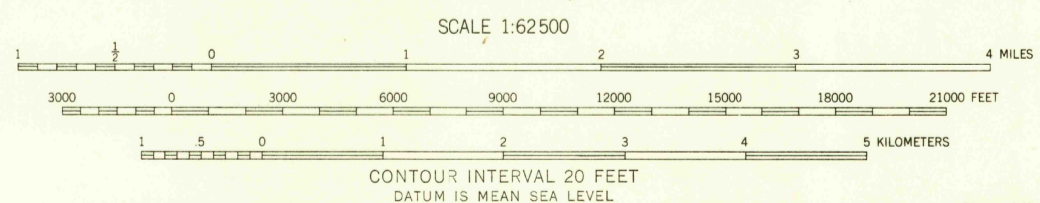


THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF PEOSTA QUADRANGLE
