Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Idaho coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)

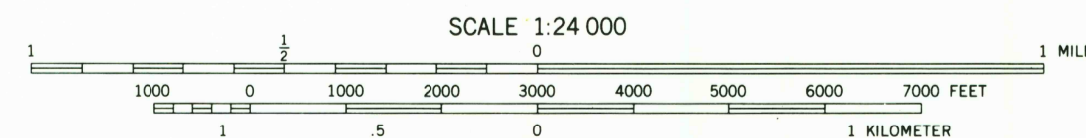
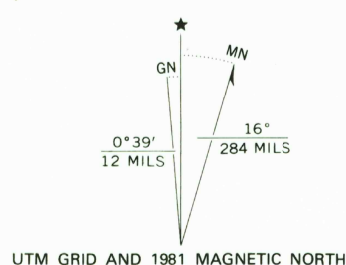
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 12 1927 North American Datum
