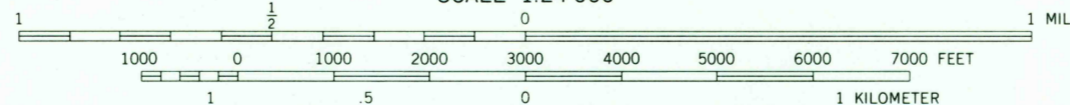
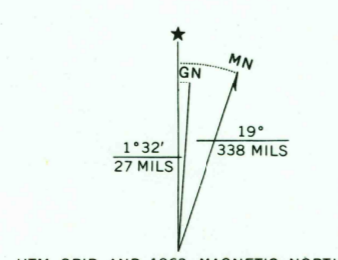
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1957. Field checked 1963

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 14 meters north and 73 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Where omitted, land lines have not been established
