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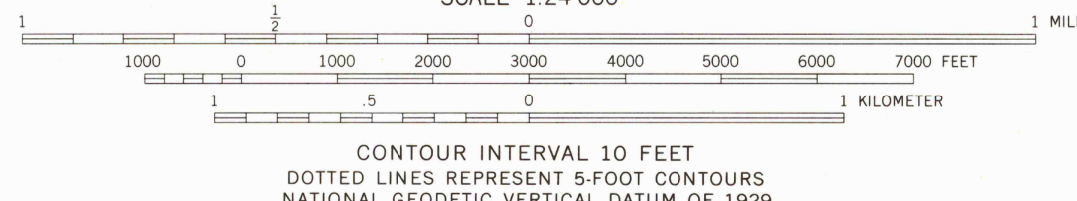
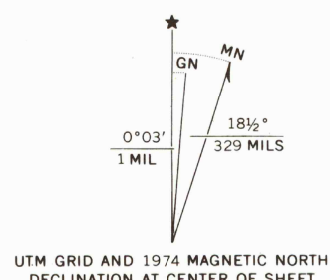

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

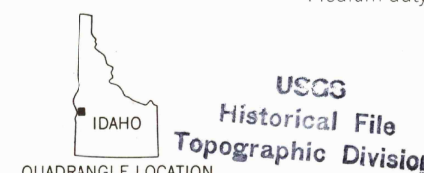
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
