

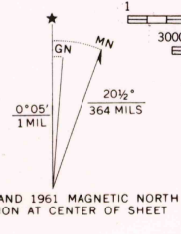

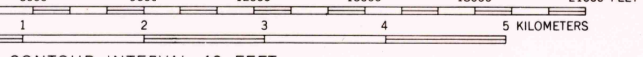
North half compiled in 1961 from 1:24 000-scale maps dated 1960

zone 11, shown in blue

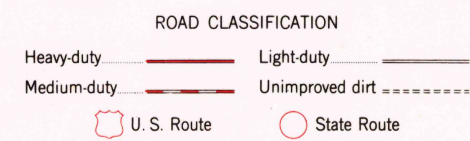
Red tint indicates area in which only
