

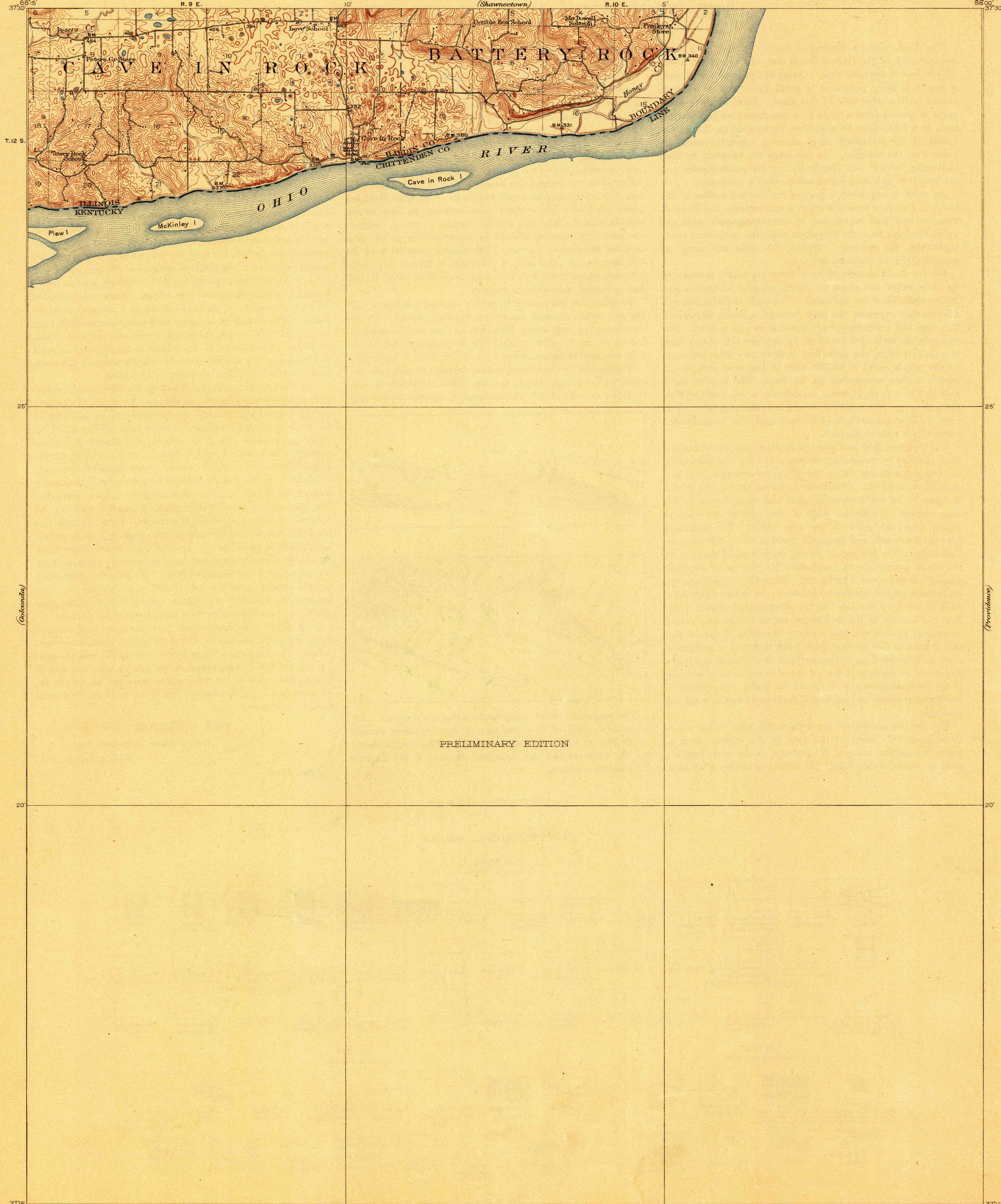

FORDS FERRY QUADRANGLE

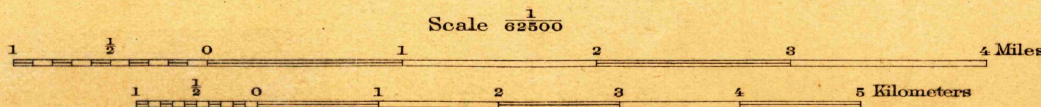
