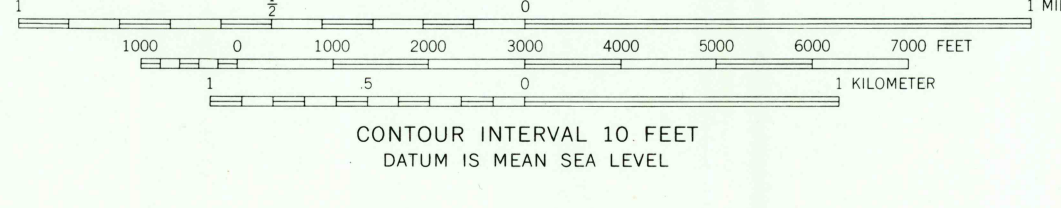
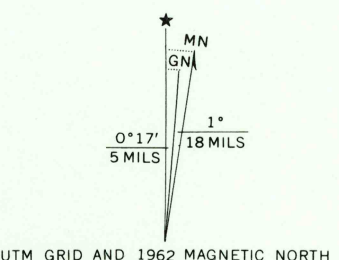
10,000-foot grids based on Indiana coordinate system, west and east zones
