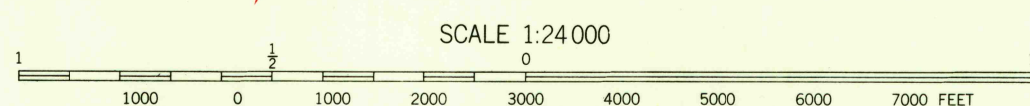


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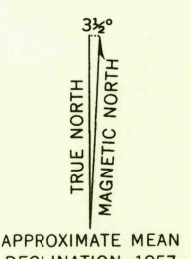
Culture and drainage, in Indiana, in part compiled from aerial photographs taken 1956. Topography by photogrammetric methods and plane-table surveys 1957
