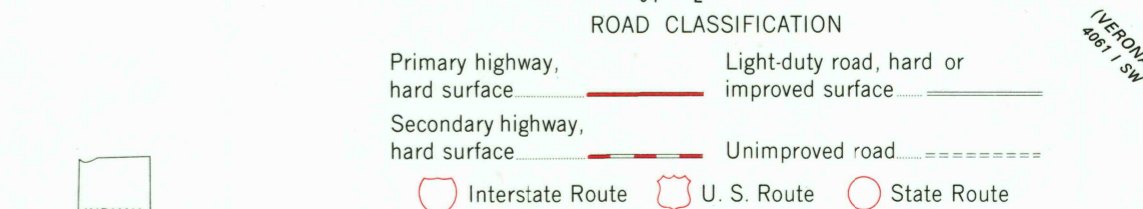
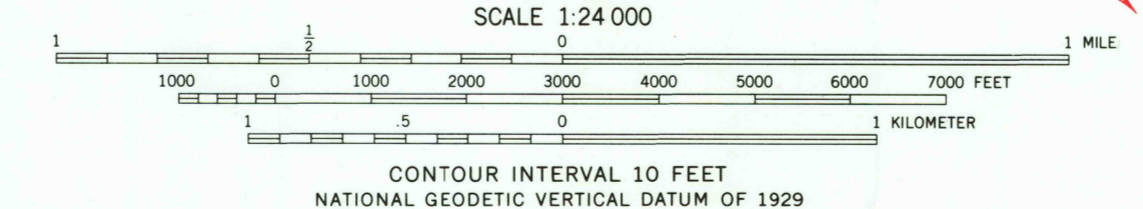
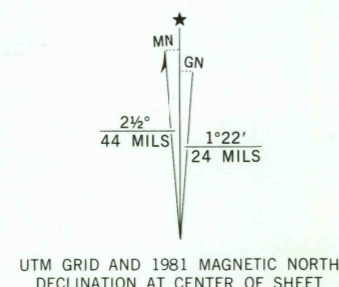

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 5 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1911-1914, and supplementary information.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.



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
