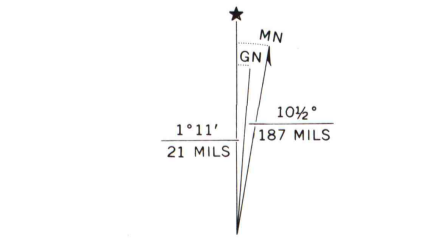

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

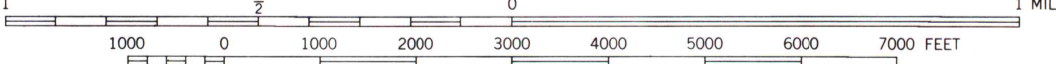
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1974. This information not field checked



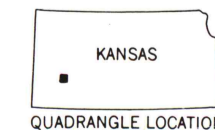
UTM GRID AND 1974 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
