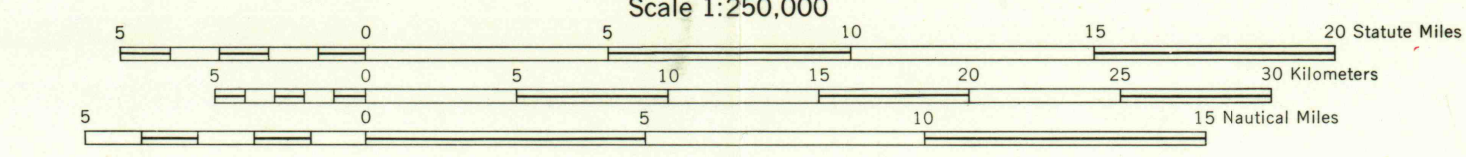

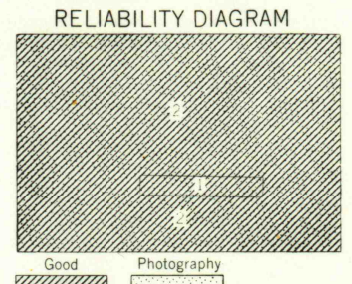
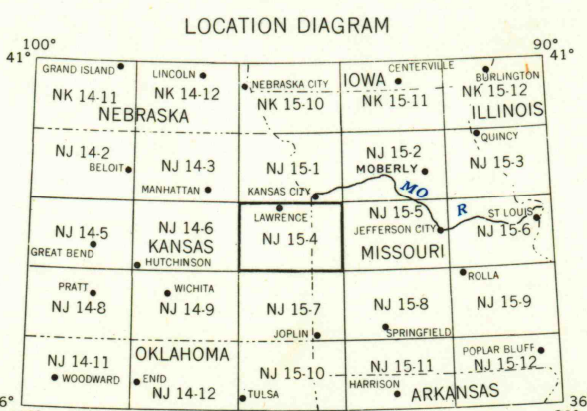
Approximate road alignment
