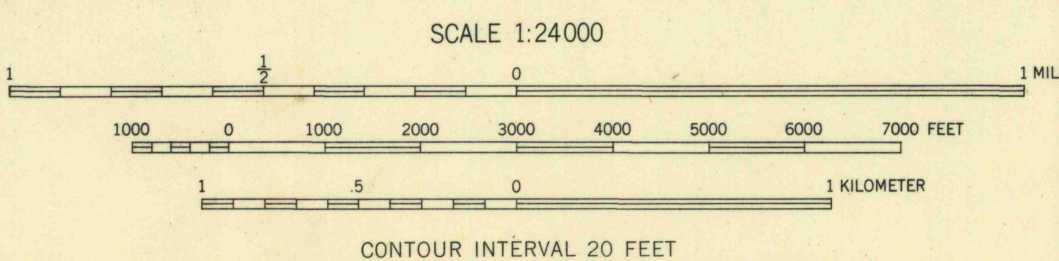




THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF THE CEREDO QUADRANGLE
SURVEYED IN 1900 AND 1901, SCALE 1:62,500

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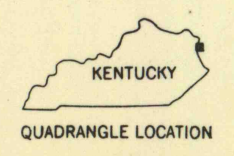
