

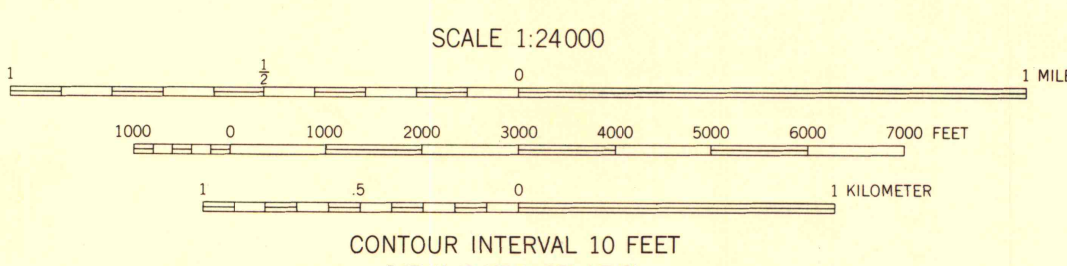

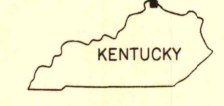
COVINGTON QUADRANGLE
