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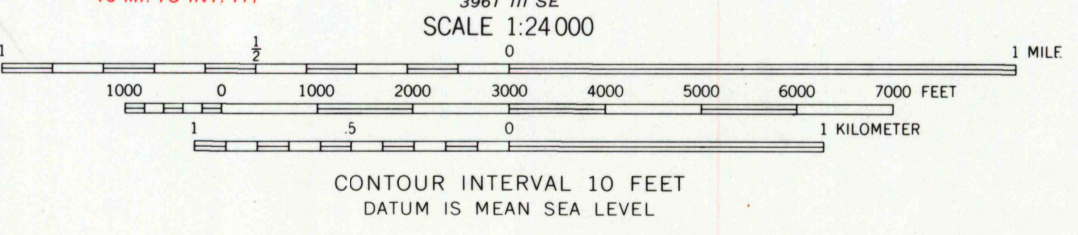

The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River Charts surveyed 1911, and supplementary information

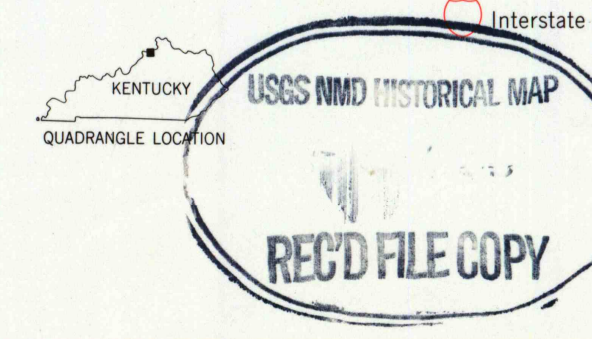
