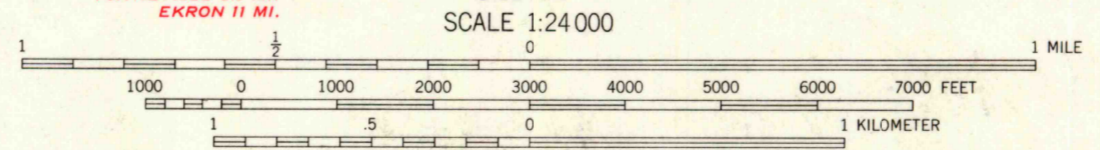
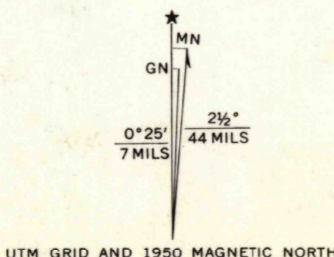




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Topography in Kentucky from aerial photographs by multiplex methods

zone 16, shown in blue

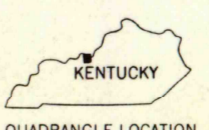


CONTOUR INTERVAL IN KENTUCKY 20 FEET
