

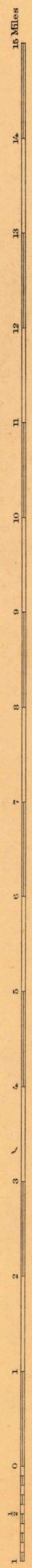

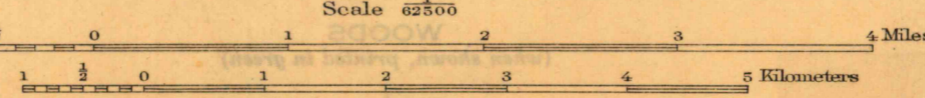
KENTUCKY-WEST VIRGINIA
