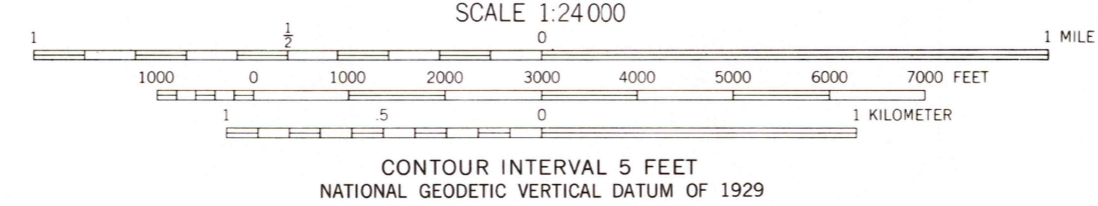
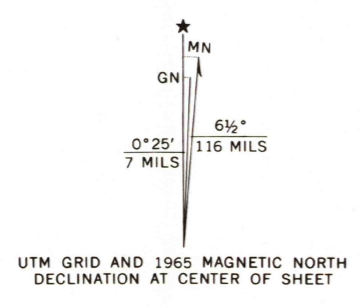
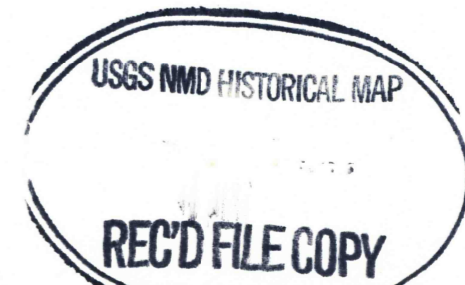


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Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1965. Topography by planetable surveys 1965

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 16 meters south and 12 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
