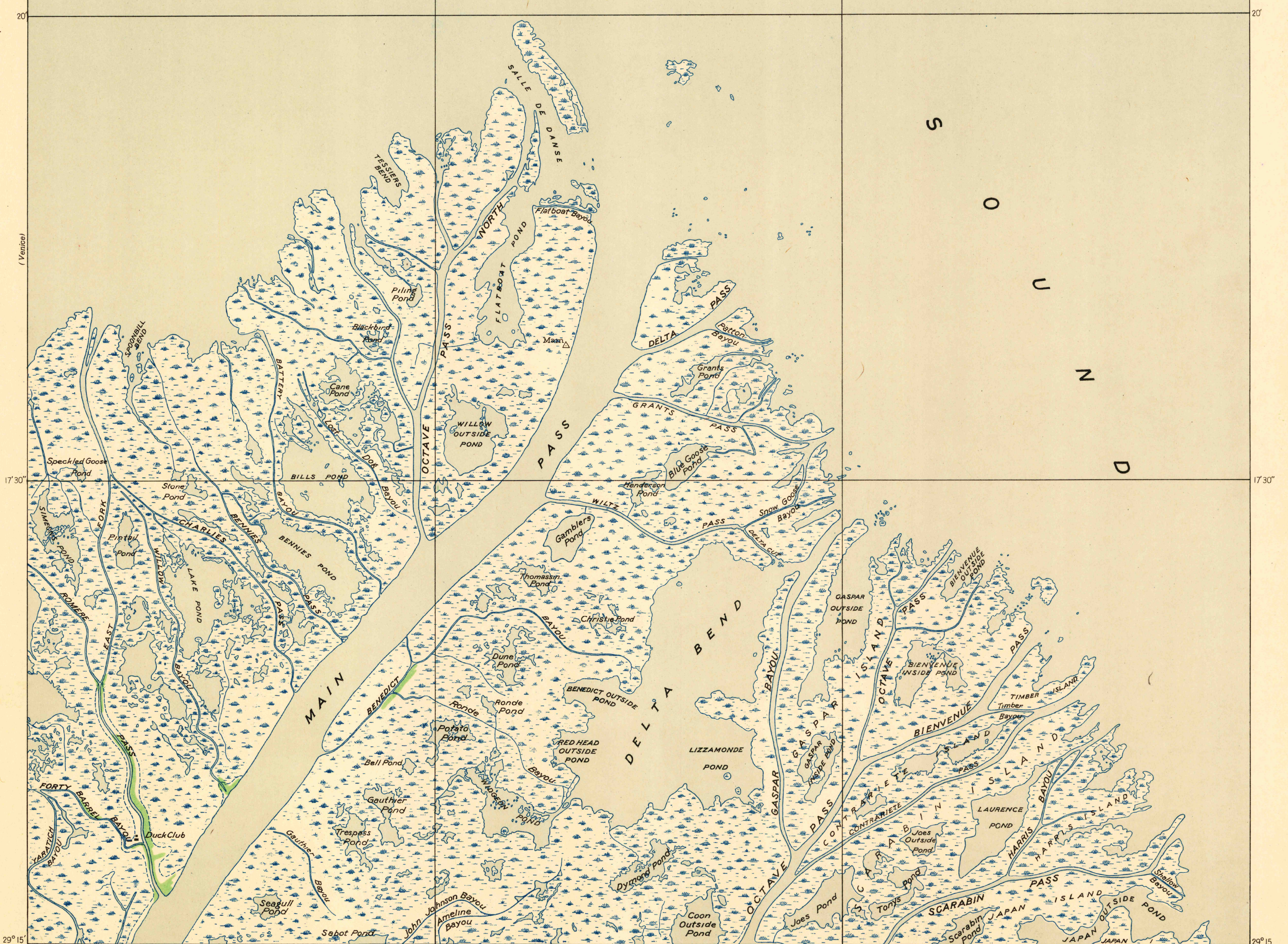

MAIN PASS QUADRANGLE

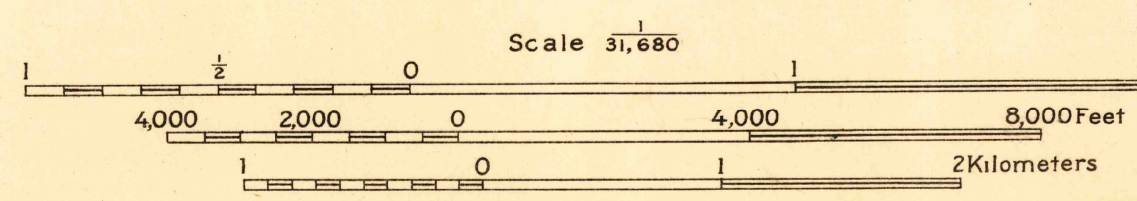
