

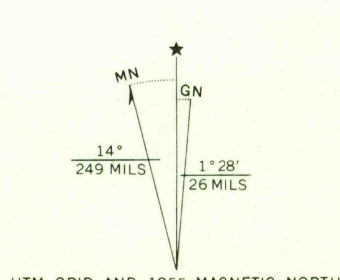

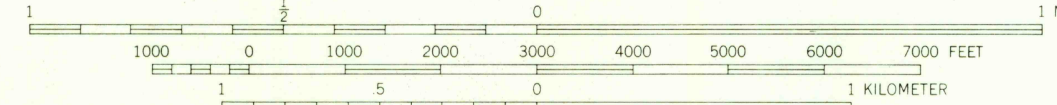

to 610 feet



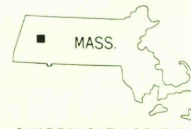
