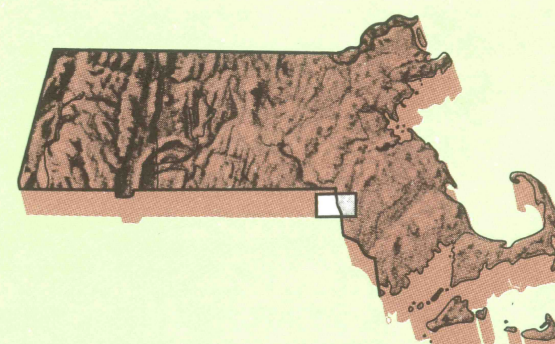

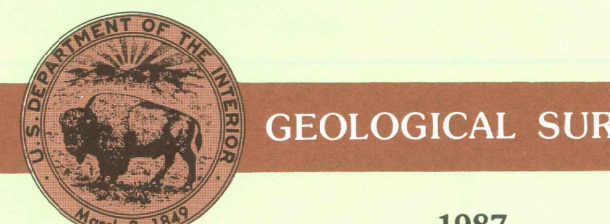
MASSACHUSETTS—RHODE ISLAND

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 5 meters south and 41 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

- Secondary highway, hard surface
- Light-duty road, hard or improved surface
- Unimproved road, soil
- Route marker: Interstate, U.S. State
- Railroad: standard gage; narrow gage
- Bridge, drawbridge
- Fordage; overpass; underpass
- Built-up area: only selected landmark buildings shown
- House; barn; church; school; large structure
- Boundary: National, with monument
- State
- County, parish
- Civil township, precinct, district
- Incorporated city, village, town
- National or State reservation; small park
- Land grant with monument; found section corner
- U.S. public lands survey; range, township; section
- Range, township; section line; location approximate
- Fence or field line
- Power transmission line, located tower
- Dam; dam with lock
- Cemetery; grave
- Compass rose; picnic area; U.S. location monument
- Windmill; water well; spring
- Mine shaft; prospect; adit or cave
- Control: national marker; vertical marker; spot elevation
- Contours: index; intermediate; supplementary; depression
