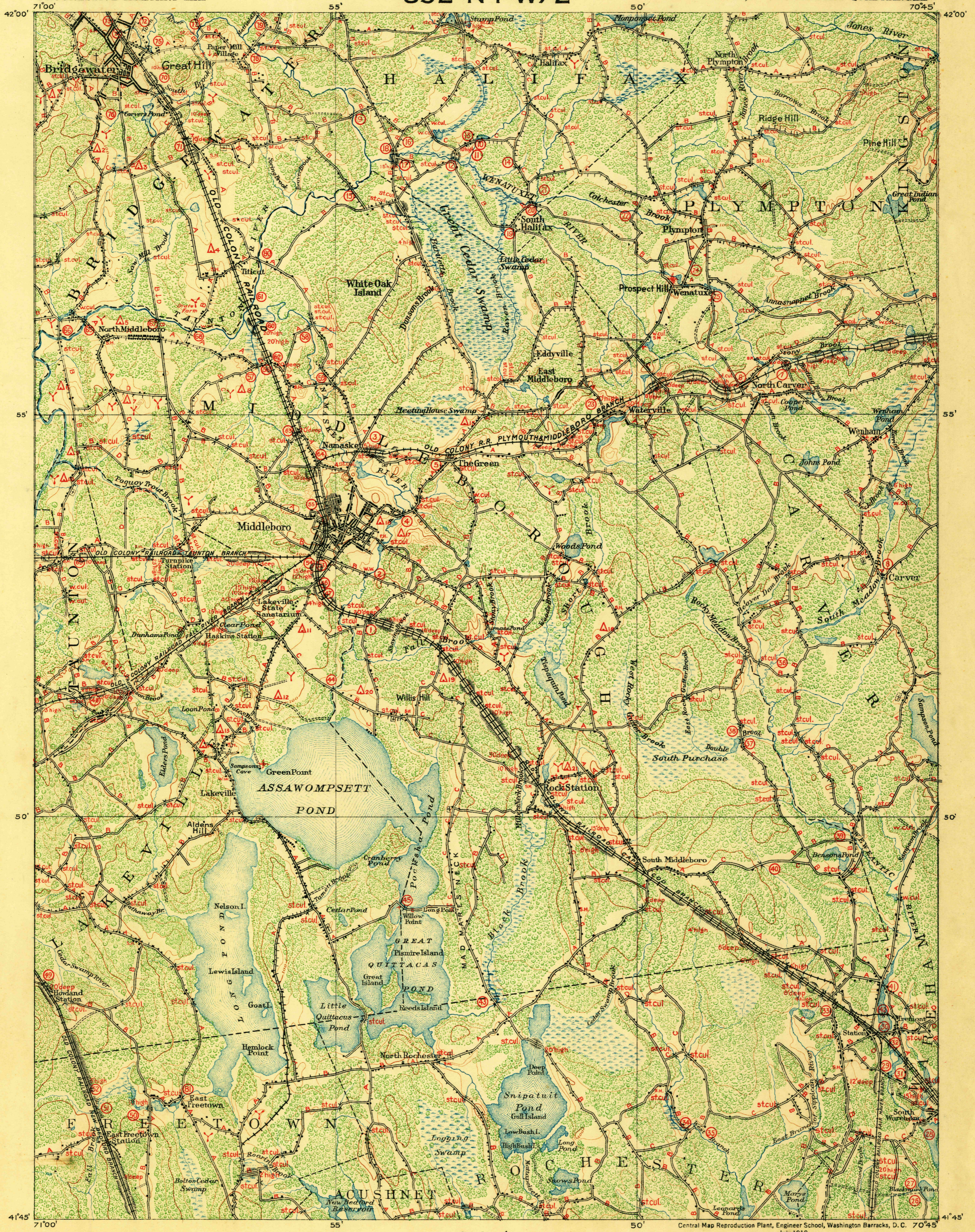


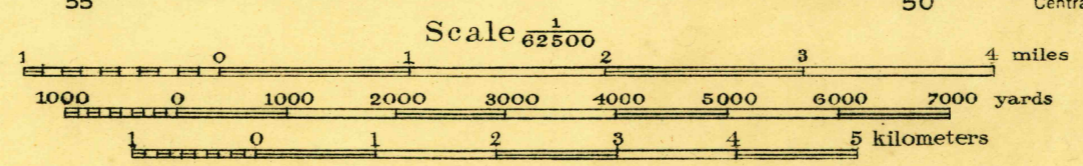
CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U.S. ARMY
