

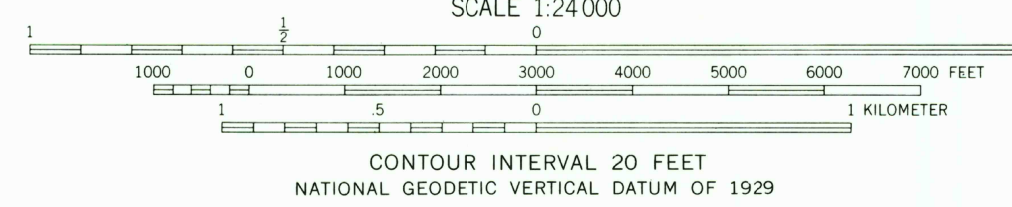
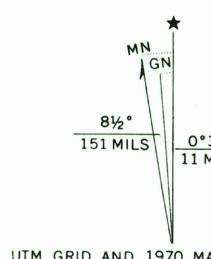

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Maryland coordinate system, and Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters south and 29 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
