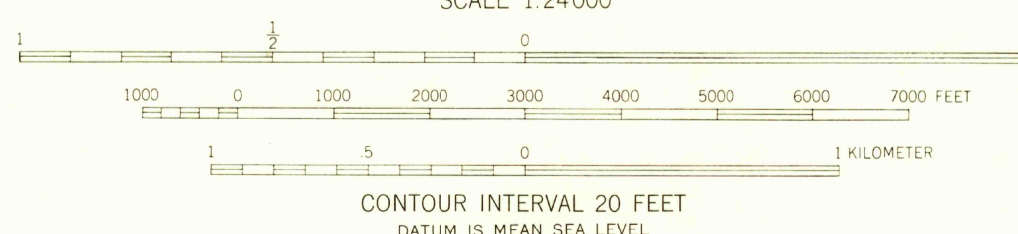
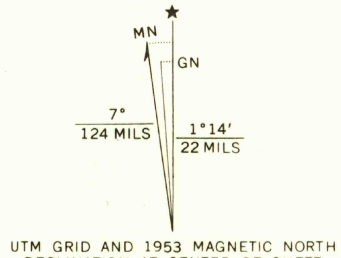
FINKSBURG QUADRANGLE

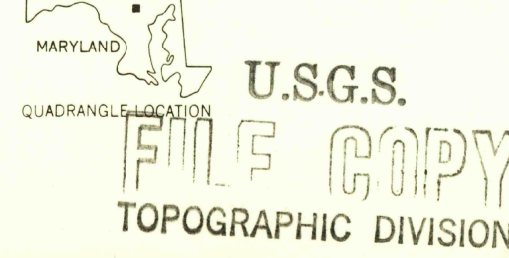
