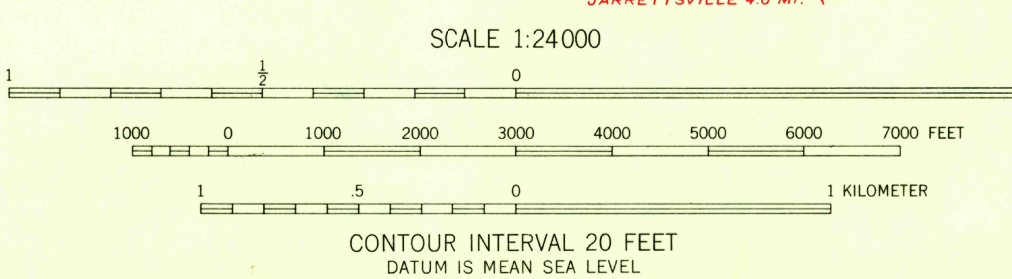
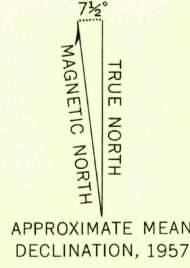
10,000-foot grids based on Maryland coordinate system,
