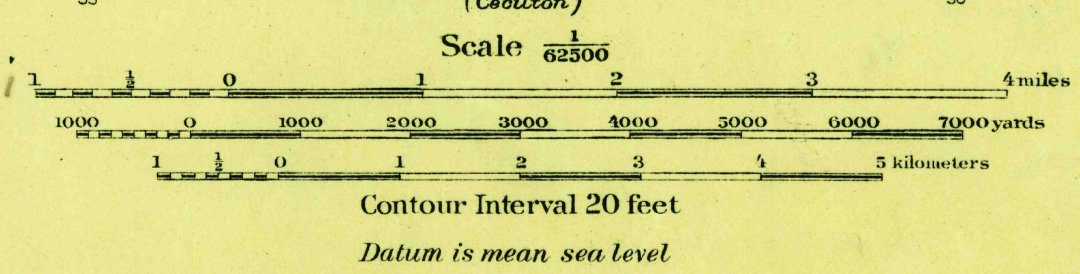
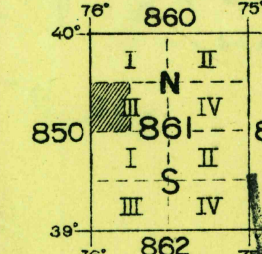


Base map from U.S.G.S. engravings
