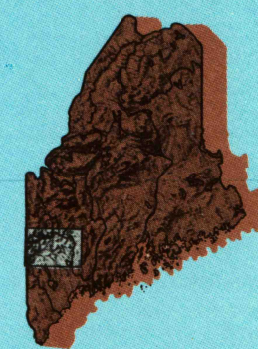

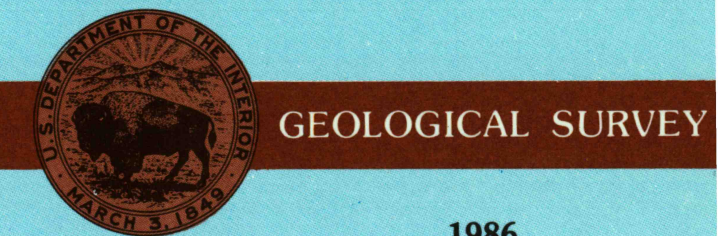
MAINE-NEW HAMPSHIRE
