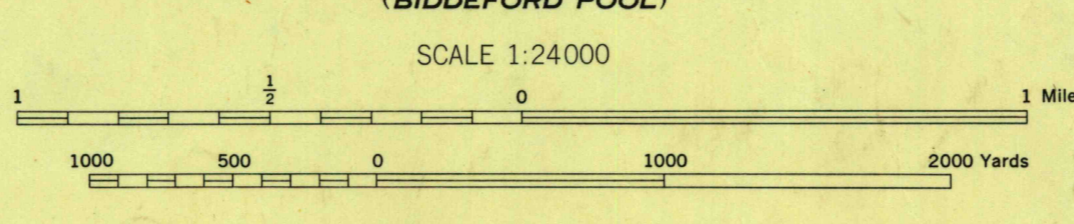

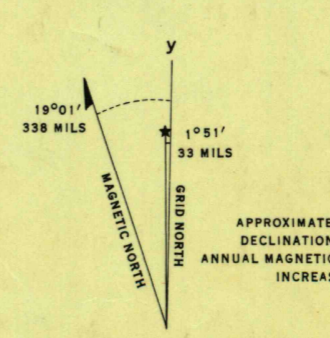
**ROAD CLASSIFICATION 1944**
