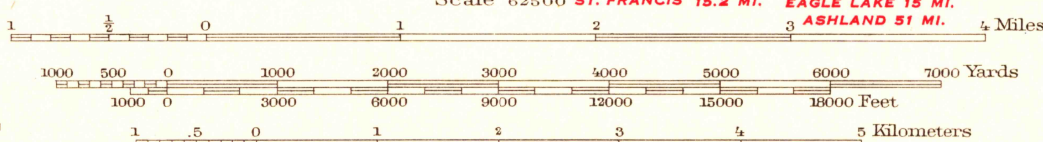

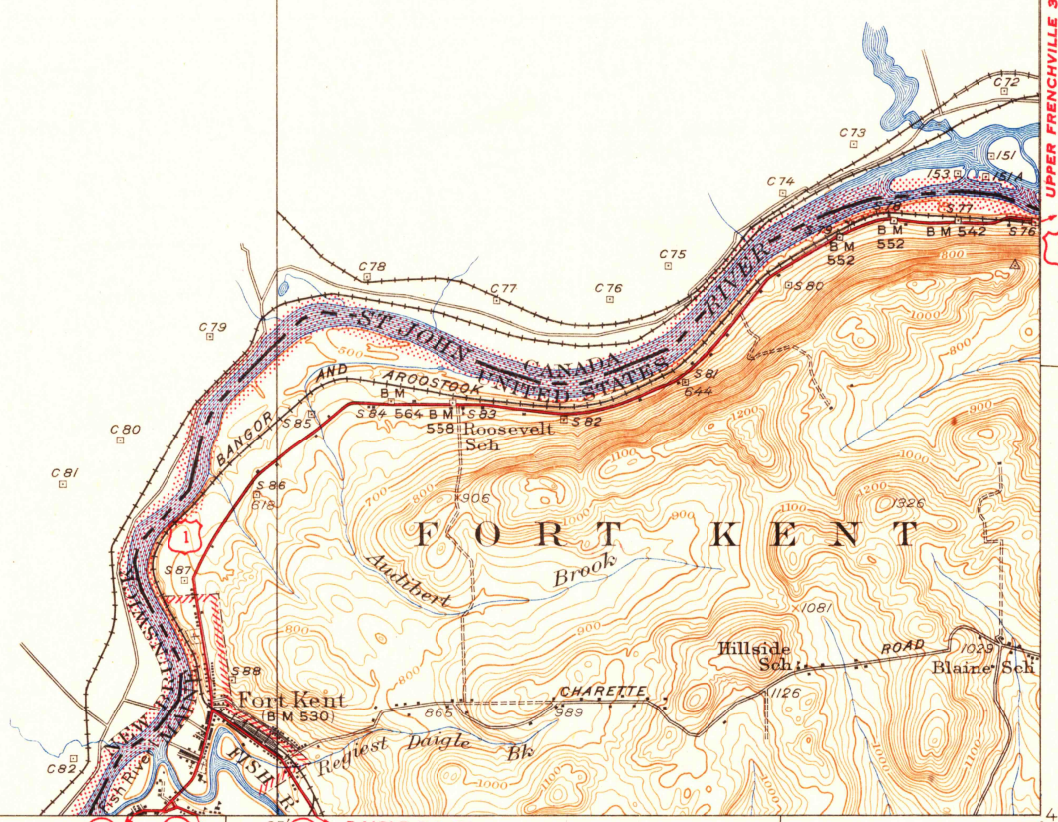


(Eagle Lake) ST. JOHN 10.6 MI. DAIGLE 7.8 MI. CARIBOU 44 MI.
