

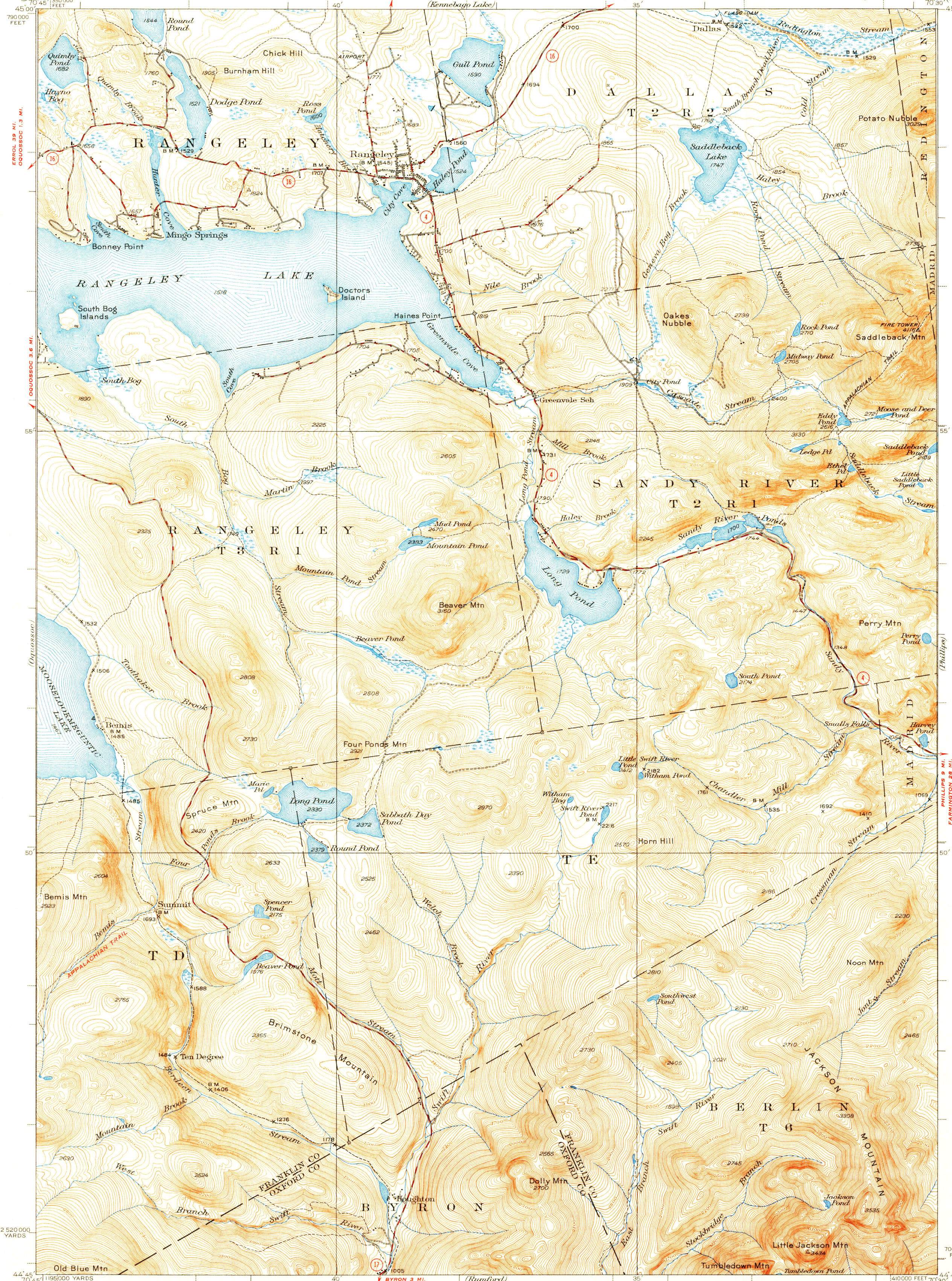

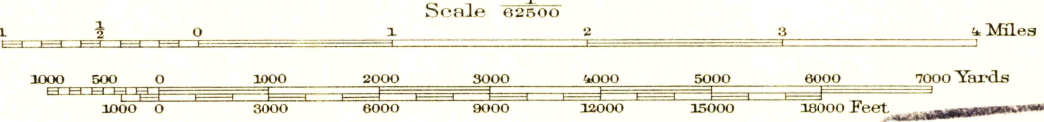
MAINE RANGELEY QUADRANGLE
